### Payment Options & Access Information

- **Insurance Coverage:** Most state facilities (including NMRC) and public clinics accept New Mexico Medicaid (Centennial Care), Medicare, and private health plans.
- **Sliding-Fee Scale:** Uninsured individuals can request sliding-fee options based on household income. Lack of payment capability should not prevent seeking medical help.
- **Emergency Care:** For severe medical emergencies, overdose, or acute alcohol withdrawal, proceed immediately to the nearest emergency department (e.g., Eastern New Mexico Medical Center).
